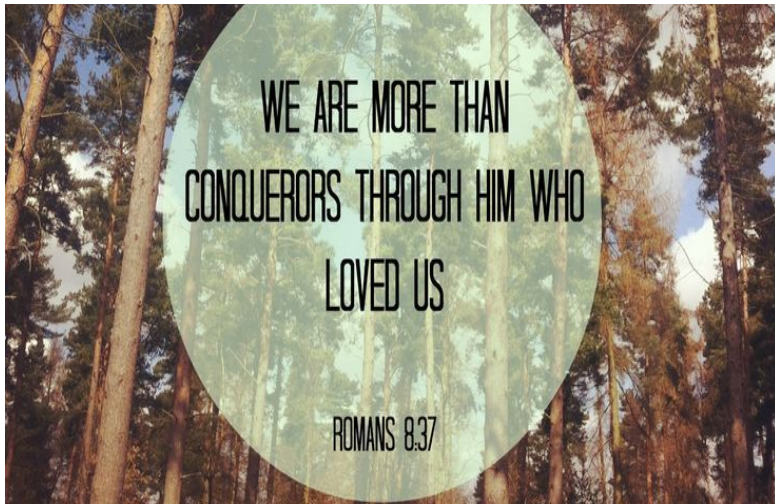

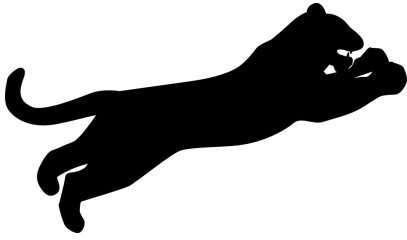
## Sixth, Seventh, & Eighth Grade

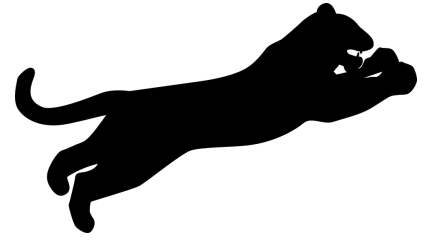
